If you are looking for an agency to be your payee, you can find payee services providers on the internet, and in the phone book. Contact your local Social Security office for other options.

Who do I call to get the requirements in serving as a payee?

**Answer: Social Security 1-252-792-8108 (Greenville, N.C. number)
Go to 2805 South Charles Blvd Greenville, N.C. with the person you want to help. Social Security will listen to the client’s needs for a “payee”. The client must go with you to Social Security.
Call Social Security for further directions and requirements before you go.**
