Detention Officer

- Educational Level:** High School Diploma or GED
- Duties:** Detention Officers under general supervision, performs a variety of law enforcement duties in the care, custody, and security of all prisoners in the Bertie-Martin Regional Jail. Duties include performing intake, detention work in accordance with established policies and procedures, observation and accompaniment of inmates inside the detention center. Employees may be assigned to work any shift. Employee is responsible for maintaining the safety and security of all personnel, inmates and jail. The employee is subject to the usual hazards of law enforcement work. Work is performed under the supervision of the Detention Sergeant and is evaluated through observation. Must be able to work 12hr. shifts.
- Starting Pay:** \$31,019 - \$33,019 DOQ (*Depend On Qualifications*) plus an optional \$2,500.00 Sign On Bonus. Supplemental Compensation, up to \$3000 per year, is available including an excellent benefits package.
- Requirements:** Must be a United States citizen or must be able to present proof of naturalization. Must have a High School Diploma or equivalent and be at least twenty-one (21) years of age (correspondence diplomas are not accepted by N.C. Sheriffs’ Standards Division). Must have no serious criminal history which would prevent the applicant from being able to obtain certification from the North Carolina Sheriffs’ Education and Training Standards Commission. Must have a valid North Carolina Driver’s License. Criminal background investigation may be conducted on interested applicants to determine suitability.
