

Part-time RN/Home Health Coordinator

Martin County is seeking applicants for a part-time RN/Home Health Coordinator for the Martin County Adult & Aging Services Department for 20 hours per week. Under general supervision, the purpose of this position is to oversee the delivery of home health care to 60+ population in the community. Work involves conducting in home visits to assess needs of potential clients; assigning personal care workers to clients; monitoring services provided and client progress; on-call for client emergencies; complete program-related documents for each client; reassess clients on a scheduled basis to reaffirm needs; perform 16 hours per year in-service training to all CNAs on staff; complete annual home health license renewal process; will manage VRI program (in-home emergency response system); will assist with meeting SCOPE certification standards for a Senior Center of Excellence; perform related work as required.

A Registered Nurse's degree is required. A valid driver's license is required. Pre-employment drug screening and criminal history check required. Salary depends on experience.
